Monitor and contribute to state and local policies regarding public health and environmental issues.



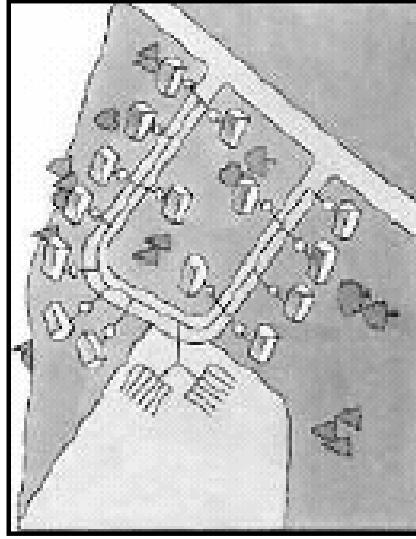

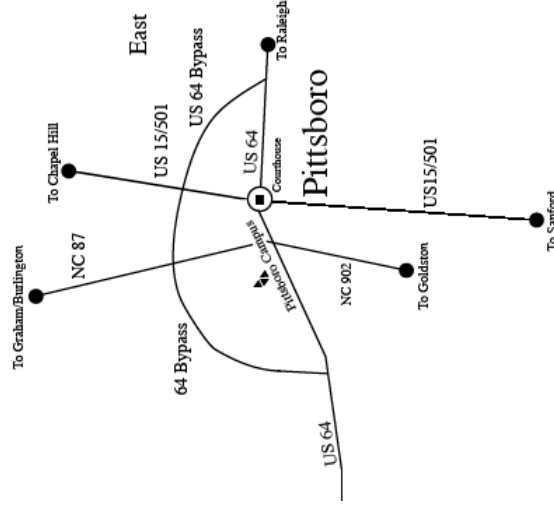
